PROCEEDINGS:

The Honourable Minister for Electricity, Prohibition and Excise in the floor of Assembly on 31.05.2018 in the Energy Department Demand No 14 of 2018-2019 has made the following announcement:

“In order to fast track, effecting of agriculture service connections for the pending applicants, new free agriculture service connections will be effected for 10,000 willing applicants in the pending list against a onetime payment of Rs.2.50 Lakhs for 5 HP motor, Rs.2.75 Lakhs for 7.5 HP motor, Rs.3 Lakhs for 10 HP motor and Rs.4 Lakhs for 15 HP motor through fast track (Tatkal) scheme for this year also”.

In this regard, the following are informed:

1. Self financing schemes are being implemented by TANGEDCO based on the directions of Government of TamilNadu from the year 1992 itself.
2. As on 31.03.18, there are 4.42 lakh agriculture applications pending and it is difficult to clear the applications in near future.
3. Under normal scheme, applications registered up to 31.3.2000 have been released for effecting agriculture service connection.
4. There is appreciable response from the farmers for Tatkal Self financing scheme introduced by the Government during 2017-18 and are requesting for continuation of the scheme.

5. Promoting agricultural growth of the State irrespective of the economic condition of the farmers could be achieved by effecting more number of agriculture service connections through Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme as the willing applicants pay one time lumpsum charges.

6. Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme is only optional scheme and will be on the willingness of the registered applicant and it does not affect the regular waiting seniority of the applicants. Separate priority of Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme shall be followed for effecting service connection.

7. During the year 2017-18, Government order was issued by the Energy Department vide G.O. (Ms) No.3 Energy (C1) Department dated 19.01.2018 for Tatkal Self Financing Scheme.

8. Now, the Honourable Minister for Electricity has announced the Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme for the year 2018-19 vide Energy Department Demand No 14 of 2018-2019 in the floor of assembly on 31.5.18. Based on this Government directions, TANGEDCO has proposed to implement the Fast track (tatkal) self financing scheme during 18-19.

In this regard, for implementation of Fast track (tatkal) self financing scheme during year 18-19, the following instructions are issued:

- i. The scheme will be called as Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme in short 'FTSFS 18-19' and is with effect from 01.07.2018. This scheme is optional and purely on the willingness of applicants. Total numbers of beneficiaries are 10000 numbers.
- ii. All the pending agriculture applications registered upto 31.7.18 under LT tariff IV for the load upto 15 HP may be considered for this scheme and collect the scheme cost (Demand draft drawn in favour of SEs/EDC) in account code 55.109 as detailed below:

Above 10 HP to 15 HP	-	Rs.4.00 Lakhs

- iii. The tentative Circle wise target has been arrived proportionately based on the pending applications and is enclosed as Annexure. The Regional Chief Engineers will reallocate Division wise Target. However, the tentative target is liable to be revised.
- iv. Name transfer and SF change if any should be completed before registration. Reduction of load is not permitted. After verifying the revenue documents as per

Form-2 of TNERC Distribution code , NOC (if applicable), the willingness application and Demand Draft may be accepted.

- v. Separate section priority should be maintained for Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing Scheme and to take up the work for the paid cases separately and complete the works as mere, minor, major as per section priority. All pending ready parties in other schemes are to be completed simultaneously.
- vi. The Regional Chief Engineers/Distribution shall implement and monitor the Fast track (Tatkal) Self financing scheme 18-19 and send the progress report to CE/Planning & RC on every fortnight.
- vii. The expenditure is chargeable to TANGEDCO - A/c code No.55.109.
